



# East Cleveland Residents: Important Service Information



## TRASH GUIDELINES

- Trash should be placed at the curb (no more than 3 feet from the road) the night before your service day.
- Yard waste is collected with trash. Brush placed at the curb must be tied in bundles no larger than 4 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- Rocks, dirt or construction debris should not be put in the trash. Construction containers are available for rent. For more information, please contact Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171.
- Rumpke is not required to remove construction debris as a result of repairs implemented by private contractors hired by the resident/homeowner.
- Please contact Rumpke 24 hours in advance at 1-800-828-8171 if you are disposing of a bulk item.

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Batteries, dead animals, tires, paint, auto or mechanical fluids, gas cylinders and auto parts should not be put in the trash containers.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

- Dead Animals
- Dirt/soil and contaminated dirt/soil
- Dry wall, concrete, bricks, dirt and rocks.
- Empty containers including drums, tanks, 5-gallon pails, aerosol cans
- Explosives
- Fluorescent light bulbs, lamps and ballasts
- Hazardous Waste
- Hospital Beds
- Liquids
- Manufacturing/process waste—sludge, sand, dust, filters, shot blast, various paint Wastes
- Medical/infectious/biohazard waste
- Motor Oil
