How to Report Illegal Dumping

In the City of Cleveland

Call 311 or the Cleveland Police non-emergency line at (216) 621-1234.

In Other Cuyahoga County Communities

Call the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Office at (216) 217-2720 to report an illegal dump site.

If you witness illegal dumping in progress, call your local police department's non-emergency number to report the illegal activity. Once a report is made, request that they forward the report to the Environmental Crimes Task Force for investigation.

Crime Stoppers of Cuyahoga County

Crime Stoppers will pay a cash reward for information leading to the arrest and indictment of any suspected illegal dumper. Call Crime Stoppers at (216) 252-7463.
